

# INFORMATION FOR PARTICIPANTS OF CHARITABLE SILENT AUCTION



1. Auction lots are displayed at the pre-auction exhibition during the First Charity Poker Tournament.
2. Anyone wishing to take part in auction sales must register as an auction participant directly on the day of bidding and receive the auction participant's number. Persons who have not registered are not allowed to participate in auction sales.
3. During registration the participant submits application for participation in the auction and data of an ID or representative of a legal entity (its authority).
4. The starting price of the lot for convenience is indicated in the unit units (US dollars).
5. Silent auction takes place within the exhibition during the First Charity Poker Tournament. The rates are fixed by the administrator in the bidding protocol, on a paper placed next to the lot. The rate can be made directly at the exhibition.
6. The step of the next bid is 10%.
7. The end of a silent auction takes place after the end of the First Charity Poker Tournament.
8. If the price for the lot is not raised within five minutes after auction end time is announced, the bids for the position are closed.
9. If the lot is bided within five minutes after the auction's end time announcement, the bids for this position continue until the last bid. The interval between bets should not exceed five minutes. If within five minutes after the last bid, the price for the lot remains unchanged, the bids for the position are closed.
10. The payments for the lots purchased at the auction should be made within 3 (three) days from the day of the auction.
11. The auction organizers have the right to withdraw from the sale any lot, declared for sale, without giving reasons. Withdrawal can be held both before the start of auctioning and during the auction.
12. Items purchased by the buyer at the auction are not subject of return.
